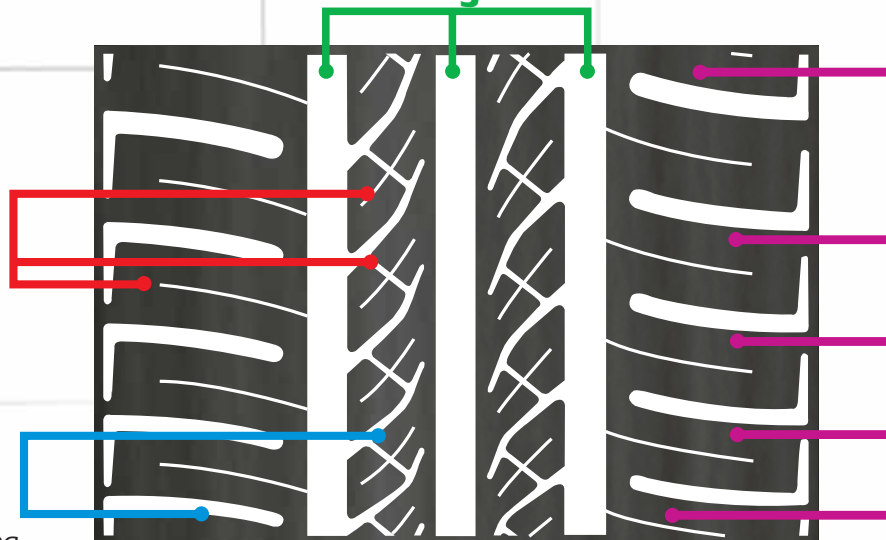

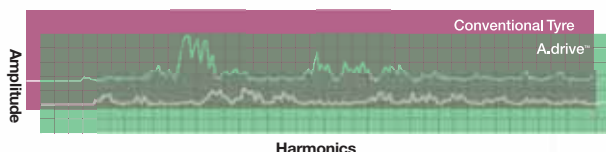

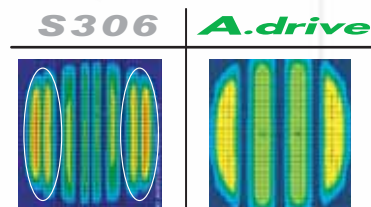
In the wet, the tread pattern's 3 wide grooves allow water to escape to maintain the contact pressure and help avoid dangerous aquaplaning.

Yokohama is a main innovator of low tyre noise technology. The A.drive benefits from the 5 pitch variation design adopted from the premium Yokohama dB decibel range. The A.drive's design has also been optimised by new "Contact Reaction Force" analysis that's used to reduce noise vibration to the barest minimum.

Safety **A+** Better Grip for Braking



The computer simulation shows how the A.drive's construction evenly distributes the tyre's all important contact pressure. The design also allows for a larger contact area for even more grip.

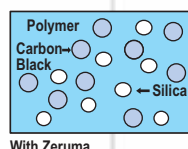

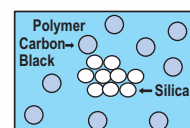

Without Zeruma

The outstanding wet-surface performance of the A.drive derives from a super-traction compound based on new silica technology. Previously, silica did not disperse readily, making it difficult to use in compounds. To overcome this, Yokohama Rubber developed Zeruma*, a special processing agent that allows an ideal diffusion of silica in rubber.

*Yokohama Rubber has filed patent applications on the advanced technology used to produce Zeruma. (PAT. EPO 761 748 A2)
